New Building Update Station #2

Commissioner Sullivan gave an update on the new building as follows:

Sewer work has been completed by Charlie Bailey, so now we are waiting for OC Sewer to come back to us stating everything is done then we will get our permit from them.

Meyer Contracting was told by OC Sewer to cap the pipe because it was an illegal hook up and when OC Sewer did a dye test they found Meyer Contracting never sapped the pipe. Meyer Contracting should be responsible if there are any fines. We need the permit from OC Sewer so we can go to the Village of Harriman Building Inspector for the certificate of occupancy.

We need to work with the Village of Harriman to secure the hole, if we can fill it in we need to contact CB Trucking. Chief Scherne will reach out to the Village of Harriman to see if they can help get it done.

Commissioner Kalter stated that we are still trying to pin down a date for Hush Electric to finish up the work on the flag pole lights, air compressor, power to the sign and the photo cell for the parking lot lights. Also, we are waiting for NYCOMCO to confirm an installdate for the apparatus bay speakers.

Ashley Mechanical came in and made a repair to the HVAC.

Commissioner Smith informed the Commissioners that Jim Ebner hooked up the ice machine in the kitchen. Commissioner's agreed that the refrigerator and freezer at Station #2 should be plugged in to make sure that they work.

Truck Update

Jim Ebner reported we went through the spec' that came in a month and half ago and we have 34 items togo over. The spec is pretty much complete it's just minor verbiage. We sent the list out to them they need to make the corrections once we see it we will be good to go.

Commissioner Kalter informed the Commissioners from this point forward he will not vote on any new members unless he sees their application prior to the meeting. The Commissioners discussed and decided that all applications must be submitted to the district secretary by the Monday prior to the districts monthly meeting.

Ian Harriton reported to the Board that previously the Commissioners approved for him to purchase a tablet for Station #3 but he would like to inform them that he did not make the purchase for the tablets have now changed from what we have.
